Kennesaw Farmers Market to Open on May 1

The Kennesaw Farmers Market will open for business this year on Tuesday, May 1 at 2753 Watts Drive (Adams Park Soccer Field Parking Lot). The market will be in operation every Tuesday through the end of October from 7 am to 1 pm, rain or shine. The Farmers Market features a variety of vegetables, fruits, and herbs grown by local farmers, as well as fresh baked breads, cakes and cookies, landscape plants and flowers, craft items, and other assorted goods.

Big Shanty Festival April 21 & 22, 2012 Kennesaw, GA.

The 36th Annual Kennesaw/Big Shanty Festival will be held in downtown Kennesaw on April 21 & 122. The festival features over 200 arts and crafts booths, 20 food booths, and 20 general booth spaces, and admission is FREE. The festival attracts over 60,000 people from all around North Georgia. There entertainment stages, alltypes of children's activities, and plenty of festival foods. The Big Shanty Festival will begin with a parade through downtown Kennesaw at 9:30 on Saturday morning, April 21st. The show hours are 10 AM -6 PM on Saturday and 12 Noon - 5 PM on Sunday. Also make plans to visit the Southern Museum of Civil War and Locomotive History home of "The General" famous Civil War locomotive. The Kennesaw/Big Shanty Festival is one of the largest festival in North Georgia.

Burning Banned May 1 – September 30

The Georgia Department of Natural Resources has issued a ban on open burning May 1 – September 30 of each year. Fifty-four counties in Georgia (including Cobb County) are affected. Cobb County Fire and Emergency Services are responsible for the enforcement of this state-issued burning ban in unincorporated Cobb County, and the cities of Acworth, Kennesaw, and Powder Springs.

From May 1 – September 30, <u>you may not</u> <u>burn</u> leaves, tree limbs, or other yard waste, forest land, or use air curtain destructors for land clearing.
